Realising potential

The Fund aims to recognise children in West Fife with footballing potential and develop that potential through our coaching programme and development squads.

Currently, the Fund supports development squads ranging in age from birth year 1991 to 1998.

We provide twice-weekly coaching sessions throughout the winter months, both indoor and outdoor, the latter at the all-weather surface in Dalgety Bay.

A complete experience

Key to the 'Norrie's' philosophy is providing young footballers with a positive learning environment and as broad an experience as possible. To this end, we encourage our squads to play friendly matches with a range of like-minded clubs within Scotland and from the SPL Youth Initiative.

We also provide the opportunity for our Under-11 squads to participate in the Haarlem Cup, one of Europe's leading youth tournaments. This has broadened the football and social horizons of all the youngsters who have been part of it.
